Local Islahi Committee (LIC) Roles and Responsibilities

(Reference: May 6, 1994 Friday Sermon by Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih IV^{ra})

Aims & Objectives

1. **Preventive:** Sniff out social ailments well before they become manifest illnesses and treat them at their root (waiting till there is a problem will turn it into a 'policing committee' as compared to a reformation committee).
2. **Remind and reform:** Following Qur'anic principles of '*amr bil maaruf wa nahi anil munkar*' (enjoin good and forbid evil; Al-Imran, 3:116), and '*fazakkir inna fa'atiz-zikra*' (so keep on admonishing people, surely admonition is, indeed, profitable; Al-A'la, 87:10), attempt to have majority on the path of goodness.

Structure & Operation

1. LICs should be established nationwide.
2. Local Tarbiyat secretary – working under the guidance of Jamaat President – will be the chairman of LIC.
3. Members of LIC include, but are not limited to: Regional missionary, Zaim Ansarullah, Qaid Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya, Local Sadr Lajna or her representative.
4. At least 6 meeting should be held in a year to focus on issues identified on the National and local level.
5. Quarterly report should be sent to the National Secretary Tarbiyat who shall submit final reports to the Khalifatul Masih.
6. LICs should avoid relying on emails/texts. Instead promote a culture of personally calling/visiting the homes of concerned members. LIC should lead by example and treat Jamaat members with love and respect.
